

8-Session Small-Group Supplemented Outlines

For use with *Proverbial Kids*® Lesson Plans for Parents

Session 5

Preparation: Preview all Proverbs verses for the upcoming session, asking God for insight in teaching.

Welcome/Cheers & Challenges—Welcome all! Invite participants to share successful, champion-building/challenging teaching moments from the past week of parenting, along with how they used the **D Lesson Plan**.

Prayer—Praise God for His great wisdom and ask that He grant wisdom to your small group participants.

Ice Breaker—Select one of the Opening Activities from the **E** plan and lead it with your small group.

[The Puzzled activity would be a fun relational exercise for your adult group, illustrating life's unknowns, magnifying God's omniscience and sovereignty. \(Adult couples need to have some childlike fun sometimes!\)](#)

Refer to the **E Lesson Plan**. Share the introductory paragraph on page (vi). Read aloud the **Key Verse** from the plan and call for volunteers to read aloud the Proverbs verses referenced at the bottom of the righthand page in the plan. Discuss each. Share the **“God’s Creation”** Bible Story at the top of the page and highlights from the other three stories.

[Review the 10 Commandments and the Greatest Commandments as God’s law for right and peaceful relationships. If you have not reviewed the parallel verses from James throughout this study, you may do so here.](#)

[Share helpful Parenting resources. \(One of my favorite principles is from Josh McDowell: Rules without Relationship leads to Rebellion.\)](#)

HOMEWork for Parents—Read aloud the short assignment. Challenge participants to continue training champions this week using the **E Lesson Plan**.

Conclude— Close session with Prayer.
