

## 8-Session Small-Group Supplemented Outlines

### For use with *Proverbial Kids® Lesson Plans for Parents*

#### Session 6

**Preparation:** Preview all Proverbs verses for the upcoming session, asking God for insight in teaching.

#### Power Point slides for ABC themes

**Welcome/Cheers & Challenges**—Welcome all! Invite participants to share successful, champion-building/challenging teaching moments from the past week of parenting, along with how they used the **E Lesson Plan**.

**Prayer**—Praise God for His great wisdom and ask that He grant wisdom to your small group participants.

**Ice Breaker**—Select one of the Opening Activities from the **F** plan and lead it with your small group.

**Refer** to the **F Lesson Plan**. Share the introductory paragraph on page (vi). Read aloud the **Key Verse** from the plan and call for volunteers to read aloud the Proverbs verses referenced at the bottom of the righthand page in the plan. Discuss each. Share the “**John’s Stage**” Bible Story and highlights from the other three stories.

**Ask for volunteers to share testimonies related to their own pursuit of fortune and fame.**

**Share** your own experience related to this topic and read aloud the **Character Book *Contentious Adeline and the Rooftop Escape***.

**This particular book touches on a wide variety of issues our contemporary families face—busy-ness, media focus, lack of contentment and peace, continuous fashion/home improvement, the influence of grandparents, the need for relationship, etc. We must ask the Lord to establish our priorities; otherwise, our commitments and hobbies can tear down our homes rather than build them. Share the Rainer quotation from the Author Notes at the end of *Contentious Adeline*.**

**HOMEWork for Parents**—Read aloud the short assignment. Challenge participants to continue training champions this week using the **F Lesson Plan**.

**Conclude**— Close session with Prayer.
